

The service of safe food should be a priority at all 4-H meetings, events, and fundraisers. Any activity where food is served (potluck, concession stand, bake sale, etc.) has the risk of food borne illness.

If your club is planning on conducting any activity that involves serving or handling food, please encourage all youth and adults involved to complete the Food Safety online training. The training takes about an hour to complete. It can be done all at once or can be done section by section at your leisure. A Certificate of Completion is given to each person who completes the training. The certificate is good for 3 years.



The first 20 families to complete the training will receive a prize! Prizes will be awarded at the March Leaders Council meeting.

Volunteer Middle Management Webpage

A webpage has been developed that details the <u>Volunteer</u> <u>Middle Management Model</u> and what it would look like in our counties.

Middle Management Structure:

Supports growth while holding true to the values of our program and is intended to do several things:

- It creates new volunteer opportunities with specific focus, allowing volunteers to spend their time where their interest lies.
- It opens volunteer involvement through an application and selection process rather than by election.
- It increases the quality of our programming, visibility in the community and the amount of youth and adults our program can serve.

The Leaders Council will vote on the adoption of this structure and the roll out. This vote will take place at the March 2014 Leaders Council Meeting.

Fair Eligibility Rules for 4-Hers

In order to exhibit at the 2014 Yuba Sutter Fair, all 4-H members must meet the following requirements:

- Online Enrollment confirmed by Nov 30, 2013
- Attendance of 80% or higher at club and project meeting of projects which will be exhibited at fair
- Attendance at one or more Bi-County 4-H event
- Presentation at appropriate club or county level
 - 1st-2nd year regular members may present at project, club or county level (primary members are exempt)
 - 3rd-5th year regular members must present at club or county level
 - 6th+ year regular members must present at county level

Club may have more strict rules but not more lenient.


