New Policies for 2014-2015

Membership:

In previous years, 4-H membership has been based on age or grade. Starting this year, we will be moving to an age only policy. Here is what it will look like:

- Primary Member: 5 years old by December 31, 2014.
- Junior, Intermediate, and Senior Members: 9 years old by December 31, 2014 and may continue in the program until December 31 of the year they turn 19.

Drinking Water:

Drinkable water must be available at all 4-H club meetings, project meetings, and events. This can be as simple as having a drinking fountain at the facility or a faucet with drinkable water. If no drinkable water is available on site, water needs to be provided. Also, all fundraisers that include the sale of beverages must include water as an option.



- ★ Projects offered by your club (needed ASAP)
- ★ Locations, date and time of club meetings

(The new location requires issuance of an insurance certificate.)



RE-ENROLLING YOUTH MEMBERS & ADULT VOLUNTEERS:

Whether or not you have enrolled in 4-H online in the past, you are already in the online system. You must simply log in and update your information when you re-enroll in 4-H.

- 1. Go to <u>California.4honline.com</u>, choose "I have a profile." Log in using the email address (*even if it is not a valid email any longer*) and password you used last year. If you forgot, lost or never had a password choose "I forgot my password." A temporary password will be emailed to you. You can also call the 4-H office and we can reset your password for you.
- 2. Once logged in, locate the name of each re-enrolling youth/adult on the screen. Click "Edit" at the far right of each name.
- 3. Click "Enroll for 2014-2015". On each page verify that all the information is correct and update the club and projects. (Projects offered may change yearly according to the volunteers in your club.)
- 4. Repeat steps 2-3 for each enrolling youth and adult in your immediate family under your family's account.
- 5. Print and submit the medical forms along with enrollments fees (made payable to your club) to your club leader or enrollment coordinator.

areas.

Youth delegates gain exposure to the campus by living in the residence halls, eating in the dining commons, and participating in educational sessions, many of which are taught by UC faculty and staff.

The conference is planned by a team of high school 4-H members and adult advisors. Working in strong youth-adult partnership, the team designs the educational, recreational and logistical components of the conference.
