COVID-19 UPDATE 03/16/2020

THE FOLLOWING IS THE LATEST UPDATE FROM COUNTY DIRECTOR WHITNEY BRIM-DEFOREST CONCERNING COVID 19, MEETINGS AND OFFICE CLOSURES:

I. Meetings/Events/Gatherings

Following UC-wide protocols, all UC ANR-hosted meetings, events and gatherings of ANY SIZE that are scheduled to take place through April 3, 2020 must be conducted via Zoom, postponed or cancelled.

This includes all in-person programming, meetings and gatherings - whether led by UC ANR employees or volunteers (e.g., 4-H club or project meetings, Master Gardener workshops, Master Food Preserver classes, and Nutrition Education programs, etc.).

In addition, UC guidance further extends the date of this directive to April 30 for UC-hosted in-person meetings or events of 150 participants or more.

II. Visitors (including program clientele, volunteers, contractors, consultants, etc.)

All visitors, including program clientele, volunteers, contractors, and consultants will not have access to the building/site unless specifically approved in advance by the UC ANR location/site director (Whitney Brim-DeForest), starting Monday, March 16. The UCCE Sutter-Yuba office **WILL ALSO BE CLOSED TO THE PUBLIC STARTING WEDNESDAY, MARCH 18**. We are planning to reopen on Monday, April 6, but we do not know yet what will occur, and will update everyone as soon as we know.



IMPORTANT: FINANCIAL POLICY REMINDERS

Treasurer's Reminders

As our clubs start holding their fundraisers and raise money for their clubs please keep the following in mind:





2. **Spending Money**—Paying for expenses is an important part of a Treasure's role. But remember, your 4-H club members must authorize all expenditures before you pay them. If the expense was included in the budget, you are authorize to pay what was planned or less. If the expense is not in the budget at all or more than what you budgeted for, you will have to receive approval from the youth members of your 4-H club at the next meeting, before you can pay the expense. Expenses should be paid via check as often as possible. Checks allow for fiscal accountability and transparency.

3. Petty Cash vs Change Fund

Petty Cash—May be needed for MISC items, not encouraged, not a substitute for sound planning and budgeting, should be reconciled regularly and should be entered in the general ledger along with the person's name to which the cash is issued. Petty cash should be used sparingly and checks should be used for most expenses.

Change Fund—May be necessary to support cash sales activities (for example, at a bake sale), purpose is make change, not petty cash and not to be used to pay expenses, established by writing a check and obtaining cash.

4-H Unit Check Dates

During the year 2020, those who write a check, need to be sure they are fully listing the year as 2020 and not abbreviating as hyphenated dates, e.g., XX/XX/20. The date written this way can be fraudulently changes to 2019, or 2021 or any other date selected. Including these extra digits will help protect 4-H checks against fraud.




