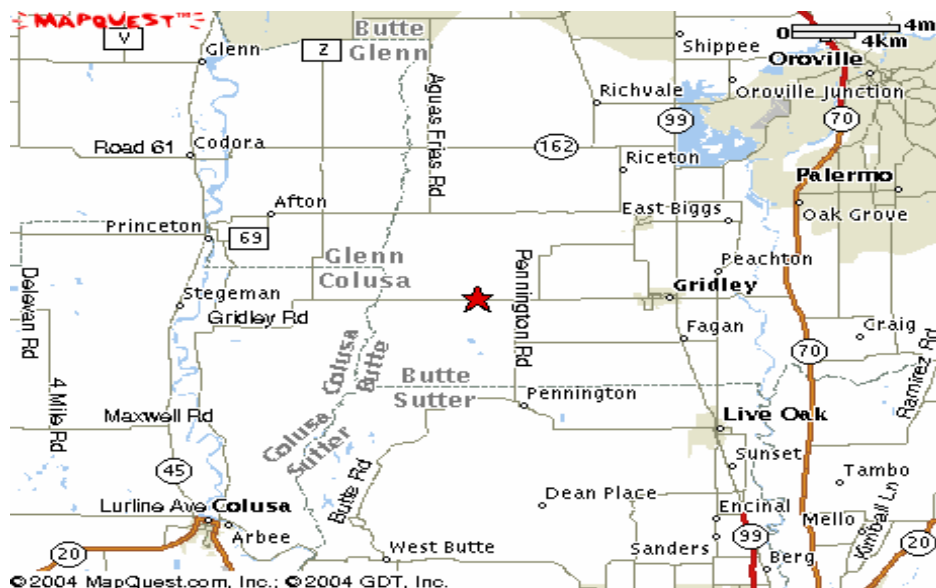

Field Meeting Sponsored by UC Cooperative Extension Split Nitrogen Application July 7, 2004



- WHERE:** King Ranch, Gridley/Colusa Highway, approximately 9 miles west of Highway 99. Meeting signs will be posted.
- TIME:** Wednesday, July 7 at 10:00 AM.
- TOPIC:** We will discuss a nitrogen fertilization experiment where M-205 is grown at several rates of nitrogen applied as various combinations of preplant, tillering, and panicle initiation treatments.

The rice plants will be at 51 days after planting. The meeting will provide the opportunity to look at plant performance thus far in response to nitrogen treatment and become familiar with the **Leaf Color Chart** to evaluate leaf nitrogen status.
