Two PCAs reported finding twig cankers with spores earlier this week & in one Andross orchard in late April. Spores on leaves were reported in one orchard today. These are blocks that have had severe rust in the past. If your orchard has not had much rust in the past, it should be fine. Plan to apply sulfur as a preventative spray before the next forecasted rain. If your orchard is a susceptible variety, like Andross, or has disease showing up now & rain is forecasted, consider a Strobilurin fungicide like Abound or a Sterol inhibitor fungicide like Elite that has some kick-back action. These fungicides can be used even if you miss applying them before a rain if you get them applied right afterward.
