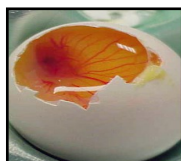
What is 4-H?

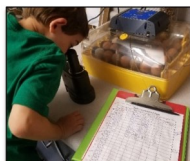

4-H Water Wizards



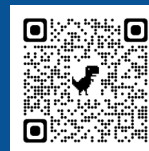
Water education projects offers hands-on, minds-on activities designed not only to educate elementary school students about water and its importance, but to engage young learners as scientists themselves.
