

Renewing Old Prune Orchards Field Meeting

A field meeting for prune growers and PCAs working with prune growers, sponsored by University of California Cooperative Extension, will be held on Friday, September 13, in the Yuba City area. The primary purpose of the meeting is to demonstrate and discuss diseased wood removal and renewal of older prune orchards. The meeting will begin at 9:00 AM (sign-in and coffee at 8:30) and end no later than 10:30. The meeting will be held at Reason Farms, southwest of Yuba City (just north of O’Banion x South Township intersection).

There will also be discussion of bacterial canker in prunes. CE hours have been requested.

From the north: Take Hwy 99 south of Yuba City to O’Banion, turn right (west) on O’Banion. Take O’Banion to South Township, turn right (north). Follow the yellow meeting signs to program site.

From the south: Take Hwy 99 north of Hwy 113 intersection, turn left (west) on first cross street (O’Banion). Take O’Banion to South Township, turn right (north). Follow the yellow meeting signs to program site.
