The Advances in Walnut Production short course will be held November 16-20, 2015 at UC Davis. The course includes four days of lectures and field demonstrations with Farm Advisors, Faculty and Specialists who represent decades of research and work experience in California walnut production.

The course program includes time for discussion, one on one time with instructors, and networking opportunities. Participants will receive lecture slides and electronic resources. A one-day optional field tour through production areas is planned on the last day.

The enrollment fee of \$1,500 will cover classroom instruction, all course materials, breakfast, coffee breaks, lunches, and evening social. **Reservations will be on a first paid, first enrolled basis.**
